BEGINNINGS

Greenhouse Project non-profit ministry really began with one man's story.

After losing everything to drug addiction, John Clifford's life was forever changed in 2006 in a jail cell when he had a personal encounter with Jesus.

Upon release, he landed in Chester where a rescue mission took him in.

John took a leadership role to help meet immediate and physical needs of the under-resourced through food, shelter, clothing, and more.

A decade later serving at the rescue mission, John realized something was still missing: lasting transformation.

Through God's leading and loving mentors, he was challenged to give back and impact a hurting city.

CHURCH FELLOWSHIP

Pastor John Clifford and Pastor Donny Martin lead our home church community *Greenhouse Fellowship* centered on following Jesus together in a family-like atmosphere to make disciples and grow God's kingdom. Men's and women's discipleship groups offer deeper connection and relational support.



ADDICTION RECOVERY

A biblical, holistic approach to recovery and life coaching - offered by certified recovery specialists - brings hope and life change to our clients. They gain access to free, long-term help with one-on-one couseling, regular in-person group meetings, and accountability.

Partnerships with local recovery centers help position individuals and loved ones for healing and lasting sobriety.



FOOD OUTREACH

Hundreds of Greenhouse Project neighbors facing food insecurity have been blessed by our weekly mobile food outreach, which distributes an average 2,400+ pounds of food each week to meet this essential need.

A thriving community garden has provided fresh produce and opportunities to learn about sustainably grown food.


This program provides homework help, learning disciplines, mentorship and consistency to at-risk youth - the most vulnerable in Chester - and their caretakers.







WHAT IS YOUR MISSION?

Greenhouse Project lives life in the struggle with neighbors because every life is meant to flourish. We cultivate gospel-centered, long-term relationships and community support for those who are struggling in Chester, PA.

Our ministry provides safe environments for life transformation through free recovery counseling, life coaching, food outreach, youth mentorship, and church fellowship.

WHO IS THE TARGET POPULATION?

Chester residents. We focus on those living within a few blocks of our house locations. Chester has over 33,500 residents where seventy percent are African American, sixteen percent Caucasin, ten percent Hispanic/Latino, and four percent mixed race or other.

WHAT IS YOUR APPROACH & WHY IS IT UNIQUE?

Our focus is creating healthy relationships living side-by-side with those who are struggling in order to create a lasting impact, believing a way to influence change is from within.

Greenhouse Project's commitment to families and the community itself is long term, as we seek to disciple neighbors into purpose-driven individuals and

self-sustaining families. The decision to walk life out with others is made regardless of circumstances.

Our simple approach is to live with, assess, and navigate solutions to a spectrum of challenges in Chester. Through this, we expect to see poverty cycles broken and generations of people transformed. Our intention is to glorify God in our lives and influence others to seek Him in theirs.

This type of approach, we believe, can renew the city from the inside, out.

WHAT ARE THE MAIN NEEDS OF THOSE SERVED?

We observe and hear directly from neighbors that our community is hurting and struggling with daily challenges including drug and alcohol addiction, violence, abuse and trauma, food insecurity, unemployment, homelessness, education fallout, and lack of access to practical resources that end these cycles.

DO YOU LISTEN TO THOSE YOU SERVE?

Yes! Living in the communities we serve - sharing life and space with neighbors – allows us to hear directly from those we serve, often times in person. We get to see and hear about their needs in order to develop practical solutions. In a broader sense, these insights help us refine programming.

HOW DO YOU MEASURE PROGRAMS?

Because much of our time is spent building authentic relationships, it can be hard to track small life changes. Currently we track attendance for most projects. A community survey will be added in 2023, as well as before/after tracking of Addiction Recovery and Homework Club progress markers.

WHAT ARE FUTURE PLANS FOR EXPANSION?

The goal for Chester is five locations, a house of refuge in each of the most challenged areas. We are praying to launch into other struggling urban areas like North Wilmington, DE; Kensignton, PA; or Camden, NJ. With an understanding that healthy leadership is key to success, we prayerfully seek God to appoint those with a passion to live and serve in new locations.

WHAT ARE YOUR BIGGEST CHALLENGES?

The realities of violence, drug abuse, and scarcity in daily life for our neighbors. There have been many shootings, two murders, and drug overdoses right on our block - some instances just footsteps away from headquarters.

HOW DO CHALLENGES IMPACT YOUR WORK?

The daily realities of living in an under-resourced urban area causes us to fervently seek God in prayer,

WHERE DOES YOUR FUNDING COME FROM?

Most Greenhouse Project funding comes from individual donors, partners, and churches. We have a few local businesses that support, and one small grant.

HAS FUNDING BEEN STABLE?

We have a small base of consistent financial partners. Most funding is received at the end of the calendar year, and through one-time gifts. We are indebted to faithful church partners like ccdelco who have embraced our mission and offered support from the start as ministry foundations were established.

with a sense of urgency to help renew our community. The challenges specific to this area inspire us to keep an "open door" policy where we make ourselves available for help as much as possible, and regularly check in on how neighbors are doing.

WHAT ARE THE MOST SIGNIFICANT EXPENDITURES?

Program expenses are eighty percent of our budget. Administrative Expenses are thirteen percent and Fundraising Expenses are eight percent. We are in our third year of ministry and working out overhead building expenses over the next few years. As a debt-free ministry committed to fiscal responsibility, we know where God guides, God provides.

Since 2021, Greenhouse Project has been a member of the Evangelical Council of Financial Accountability (ECFA), an accrediting organization dedicated to helping Christian ministries and churches uphold high standards of responsible stewardship. All Greenhouse Project services and goods are open to all people
